We have been learning about all of the travelling you can do on a bus as well as using our imagination when saying I Spy.

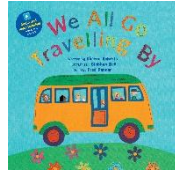
In Phonics we have been learning our new sound and letter 'V'.
