

This week the children visited their new classrooms and met their new teacher.

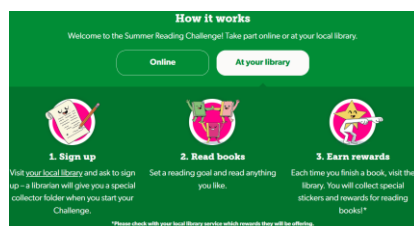
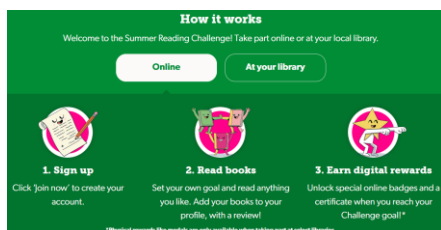

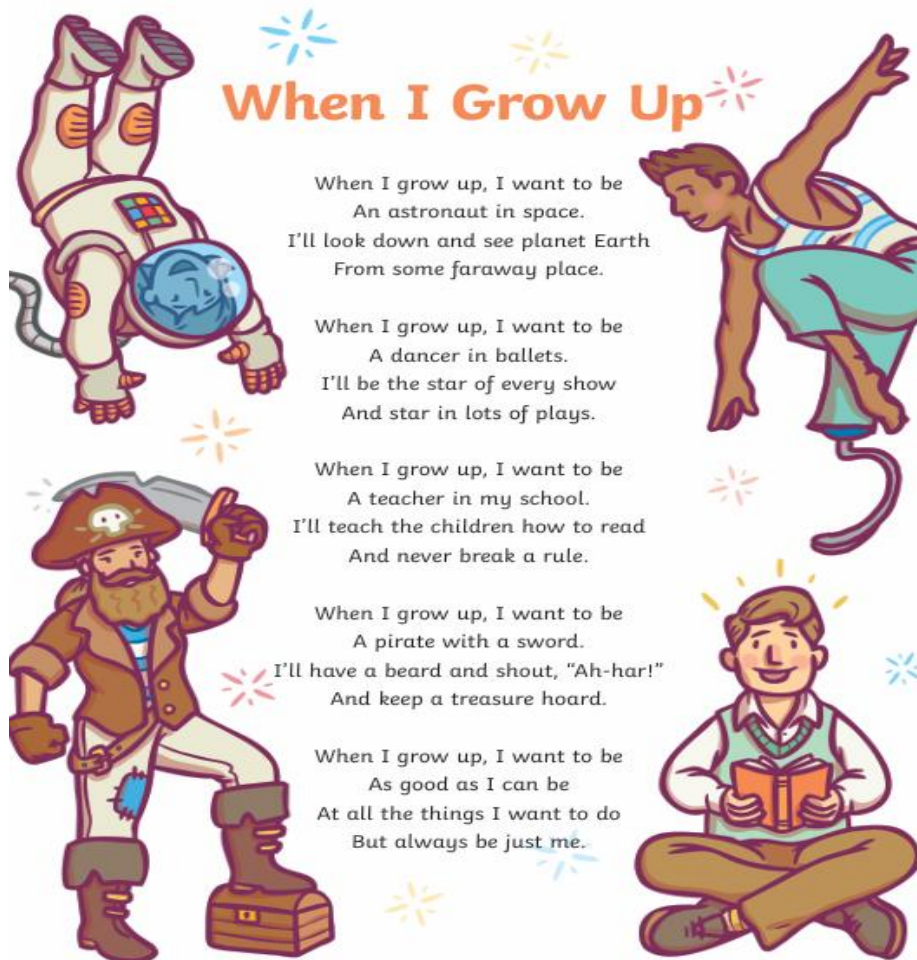

But always be just me.

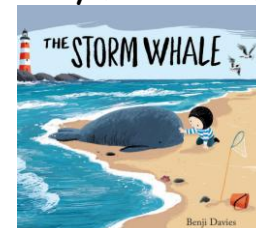
Reading
