Home learning/Online - partition these numbers and write the stem sentences to show your understanding -

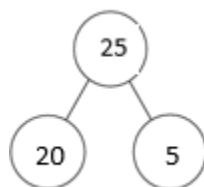
Use part-whole models to partition the numbers into tens and ones.
