

Please ensure your child practises independent sentences daily.



<u>Maths</u>

This week we have been looking at number bonds to 10. Children will be using resources to find different ways of making 10.

Next week the children will be learning about fact families. They will be given plenty of opportunities to explore part whole models and bar models, using a variety of resources to support their learning. Children have already had a go at using these models to write their own number sentences.

Home learning – Please work with your child to count to 10 and back. Also, encourage your child to write and recognise the numbers 0-10.



Geograpy: Local area – please discuss your route to school with your child and show them on a map so they are familiar with this topic.
