Home learning practise: Support your child with learning how to find more than one part of a fraction and use the bar model to check their calculations.

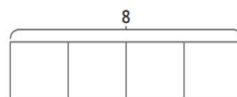
- 3 Rosie is sharing out 16 strawberries.
