<u>Easter Holidays</u> Our last school day is Thursday 28th March, finishing at 2pm. Children return for the Summer Term on Monday 15th April.

Our new natural environment! You may have noticed some changes to our Nursery. We are using more natural resources (less plastic) and calming colours. This is a whole school change to create a more holistic nurturing environment.

Mobile Phones

When you are coming onto school grounds to collect or deliver children, we would kindly ask you to refrain from using your phone. Thank you.

So, what is school readiness? Well, we see it as a measure of how prepared a child is to succeed in school, cognitively, socially and emotionally. This allows teachers to focus on developing skills and stops young children playing 'catch up', so they can develop their love for school and parents can be confident that their child is coping well with the transition.

Sadly, the last statistical data shows that in Hillingdon 1 in 2 children are 'school ready' compared to Lewisham where about 3 in 4 children are school ready -
