

Our Learning

It has been a pleasure to meet with parents this week and discuss your children's progress so far. We hope evervone has a restful half-term break.

Take a look inside book bags to see some learning that the children can keep busy with over the half term and remember to keep practicing those tricky words! Each child will have a login username and password so that they can access Bug Club. This is a wonderful online resource to encourage the children's enjoyment of stories and reading.

IMPORTANT:

Nursery Picture Books

Please can you look after our books at home and when not reading them, keep them in your child's book bag, especially if you have little ones at home!

Health & Hygiene

Please ensure your child's nails are cut short and filed down.

We ask that you teach and show children how to properly clean their runny noses so that we can limit germs spreading within Nursery.

Punctuality & Absence

If your child is going to be absent, for whatever reason, please ensure that you ring the school office by 8.40am on 020 8573 3389 pressing option 1 and leaving a message, stating your child's full name, class, and reason for absence.

Home Time

Your child's safety is extremely important to us. We ask that you continue to be patient when we are calling your children's names. We will also not be able to send your child home if you are using your mobile phone. We will not send your child home if you send a friend to collect your child if you have.
