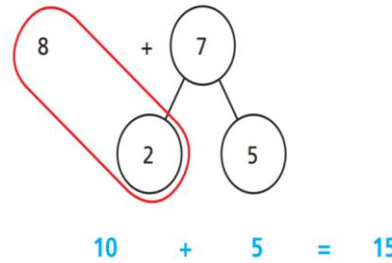
This week the children wrote a letter to persuade the Bear family to forgive Goldilocks for her actions. They were able to remember recall all their ideas from the previous learning to support them in their letter writing.



Next Week: The children will be reading a new story "Cinderella" with a focus on "Fairy tales". This is a wonderful text with amazing vocabulary and illustrations. They will be retelling the story through drama and hot seating activities.

Maths

This week we have been using our knowledge of part and whole models to support adding by crossing 10. The children needed lots of support at first but with lots of encouragement they are beginning to understand. They are now beginning to show their fluency of being able to recall pairs for numbers that make certain 1- digit numbers and transfer this to make the value of 10.



Next Week: Next week we will continue with this strategy but now using a 2- digit (Crossing ten) e.g 18 add 7
 Analogy "Because I know that 8 + 7 is 15, I also know that 18 add 2 is 20 and therefore 20 add 5 is 25"

Science: Food chain

RE - Exploring beliefs and places of worship related to celebrations.

Art - Creating a piece of art based on celebrations.

Geography - The continents of the world.
