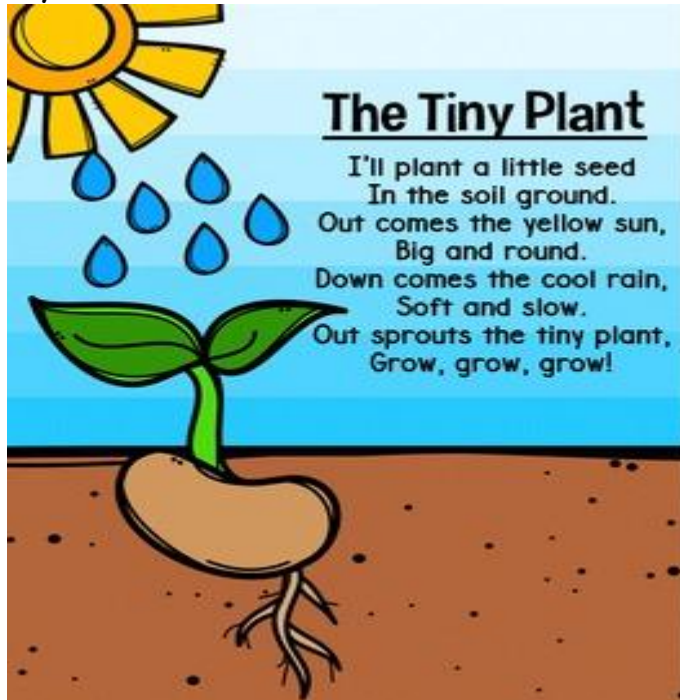

## Reading

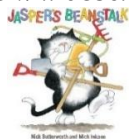
