Our Learning

This Week

The children have enjoyed their first week back to school. Their confidence and independence is really showing in Nursery!

In Phonics we recapped all our learnt sounds and have introduced our new sound 'v'. The sounds we have now covered are:

s,a,t,p,l,n,m,d,o,c,k,g,e,u,r,h,b,f,j,l

It's really important to keep practicing at home. When you are reading with your children ask them to show you what sounds they know!

We celebrated Empathy Day this week and discussed what empathy means and how we can understand other peoples emotions.

Please keep practicing name writing at home with your children!

Next Week

We have lots of exciting events to look forward to in this half term including a trip to the park, a class assembly to celebrate the achievements of your little ones and a fun day towards the end of the term.

Next week we will start our focus story 'The Little Red Hen', looking at the moral of the story and how we can show kindness within the classroom and at home. We will retell the story using puppets and actions.

In Numeracy we will focus on ordering numbers 0-10 on a number line. We will also continue to look at 'one more' and 'one less' up to 5.

We will move onto 'w' in our Phonics sessions and learn some new tricky words. Please see the back of this newsletter to look over the current tricky words that all children should be familiar with at this stage.
