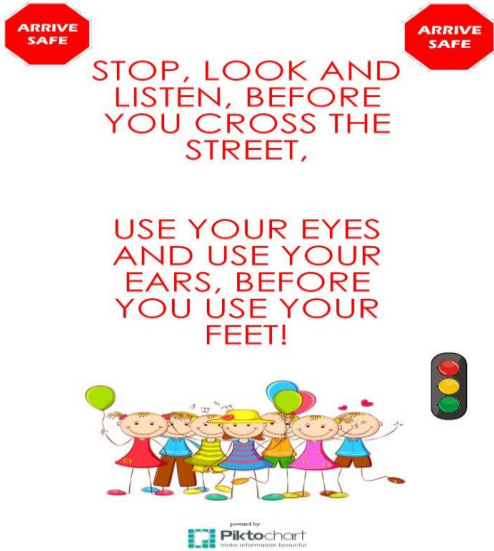

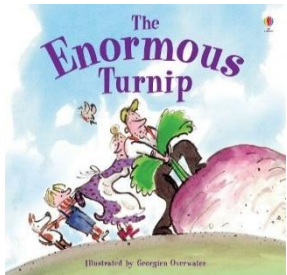
## Rhyme of the Week- Road Safety poem

## Literacy

## Maths

This week we have been looking at positional language.

**Key words:** in, on, over, under, above, below, next to, beside, in front, behind, between.

Next week we will be looking at 2D shapes, focusing on circles and triangles.

**Homework** - Matching positional words to pictures.
