




This week we enjoyed taking part in Science Week. We explored many activities related to the topic of 'adapt and change'.

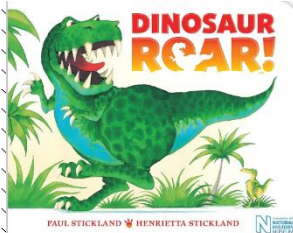
We discussed how animals change and adapt to their surroundings. We even had the pleasure of meeting some of our school reptiles.
