Phonics

We will continue to revise Phase 2 Phonics sounds for the next two weeks, we will then be moving onto Phase 3 letter sounds:

j,v,w,x,y,z,zz,qu,ch,sh,th,ng,ai,ee,igh,oa,oo,ar,or,ur,ow,oi and ear.

Please practise Phase 3 sounds at home to benefit your child's learning.

Homework - It is very important that the children can sound out and write these letters. Can the children recognise them in written form, can they hear the sound at the start of words, can the children write them?

Maths

This week we have been looking at writing numbers above 10, and recognising 2D shapes.

Homework - Please practise writing numerals above 10 as well as independently recognising 2D shapes and their names.
