This Week

The children have had a really busy and exciting week. On Thursday we celebrated World Book Day and the children engaged in lots of reading activities. Thank you all for your efforts with their outfits, they looked fantastic! The funds will help ensure all children have opportunities to access books.

The children also had their first visit from our Therapy Dog. Many children were extremely brave and stroked the trained dog and some also had questions. It was fantastic to see how gentle the children were with her.

We have been progressing with our sounds and tricky words and the children this week have learnt 'o'. Please take the time to practice formation at home!

We have also begun making pinch pots from dry clay. The children will decorate these and we will grow cress in our pots. We will discuss with the children how plants grow and the correct environment for this.

We have lots of exciting learning to do in the next half term and we will start our new focus story 'The Three Little Pigs' and begin a new topic: 'Let's Build'. We are building outside with our wooden construction kits.
