Literacy

Maths

This week we learnt how to find one less than a given number. We also practised writing number sentences.

Homework - Write simple number sentences. Take away one.

E.g. 6-1= ___ 2-1=___ Extension: 10-2=__ 12-2___

Please continue to practice number formations with your child to ensure numbers are the correct way round.
