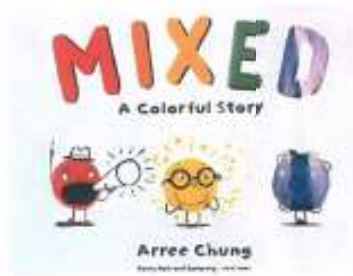
We hope this will inspire children of all ages and abilities to be physically active, which has a wonderful benefit to their fitness and mental health.
