We have been learning about different farm animals and how important it is to be kind and helpful to each other.

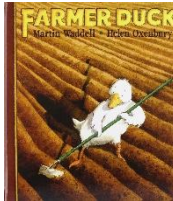
In Phonics we have been learning our new sound and letter 'u'.
