Thank you for continuing to be patient in waiting for the parents in front of you, and for following social distancing rules. We are also learning about differences of size, using our toy animals and boxes to see which fits where.

Punctuality

Clothes

We would like to remind you that your children have to wear the **correct uniform**. Thank you.

Snack Time

We will provide a piece of fruit and some milk each day for the children.

Personal Hygiene

<u>Children should be entering the nursery without nappies or pull-ups.</u> Please support children at home by encouraging them to be independent when going to the toilet. The Children's Centre (next door) may be able to provide support to parents in this area. We ask you to register with them as quickly as possible.

Mobile Phones

The school has decided on a **NO mobile phone policy in school**.

Absences

If your child is going to be absent, for whatever reason, please ensure that you ring the school office by 8.40am on 020 8573 3389 pressing **option 1** and leaving a message, stating your child's full name, class, and reason for absence.

Going home time

Your child's **safety** is **extremely** important to us. Going home time can be a busy time. We therefore ask that you continue to be patient when we are calling your children's names. We also ask that all parents and carers make a **line** at the door, to ensure that all of the children are sent home **safely**. We will also not be able to send your child home if you are using your mobile phone. We will not send your child home if you send a friend to collect your child if you have not informed the office or a member of staff before the end of the session. Therefore please let us know in advance. Thank you.
