
We had a visit from a puppy called Waffle!

Our Learning

This Week

The children have had a shorter but busy week. They really know the Goldilocks and the Three Bears story, joining in with the different voices of daddy, mummy and baby bear!

In Phonics we have been learning our new sounds 'r' and 'b' and how to write and recognise the letter.

We have been using our new vocabulary to put our classroom bear on a lap, behind, in front or next to a child during circle times.

We have been making the most of being outdoors as well as starting a new bicycle training session every Thursday. All the children spend 20 minutes using a 'balance' bike to give them confidence and new skills. We are really impressed with their progress and excitement for this new activity!

We had a lovely visit from a puppy as part of our therapy dog programme. The children showed maturity as they had a chance to stroke her.

Next Week

We will be introducing our new story book 'The Tiger who came to tea' by Judith Kerr.



In Phonics we will learn our new sound 'h' at the start of each session.

We will continue to use positional language with reference to a numberline.

The children are loving the role play café outside which is extending their imaginative play and language.
