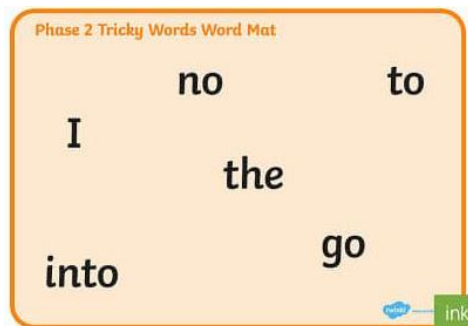

#### This Week

The children have had a lovely week, making the most of the sunny weather! We have been exploring the outside area, including the forest school and keeping cool in our water park.

In Phonics we recapped all our learnt sounds and have introduced our new sound 'w'. The sounds we have now covered are:

s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,o,c,k,g,e,u,r,h,b,f,j,l, v  
It's really important to keep practicing at home. When you are reading with your children ask them to show you what sounds they know!

We created Father's Day cards with the children and encouraged them to draw pictures of their families and people they loved.
