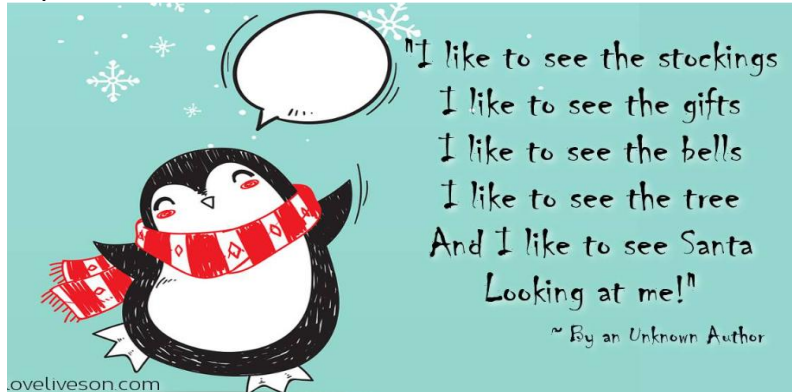

Reading

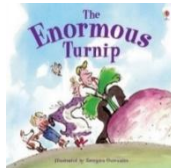
Please make sure you read with your child every day.
