Literacy


This week, we wrote about what we did in the half-term holiday.

Phonics

We are continuing to consolidate Phase 2 sounds and teach Phase 3 sounds. This week we focused on these sounds: ur (for purse), ow (for clown), and oi (for coin). Please go over all the sounds and practice word blending with them. *For example: b-ur-n, d-ow-n, and s-oi-l.*

Tricky word for this week: you.

Next week we will focus on these sounds: ear, air, ure, and er.

Homework - Please read the instructions to your child and help them with the activities. Then support them to use the tricky words to write sentences. (Don't forget to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops!)

Spellings:

This week's words: but, then, you, big, fog, log.

Please practise this week's spellings with your child.

Maths

This week we were looking at number bonds for 6. Number bonds are pairs of numbers that add up to a specific number. For example, $1+5=6$


Next week we will look at the number bonds for 7.
