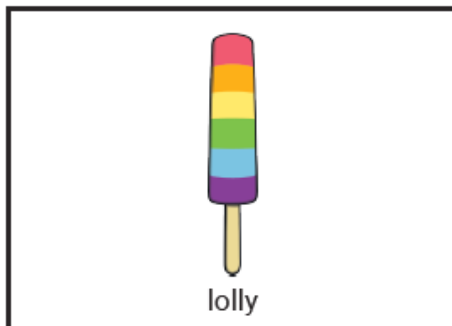


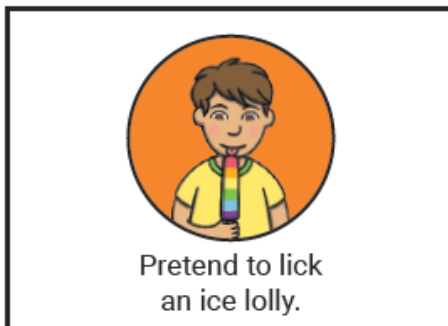

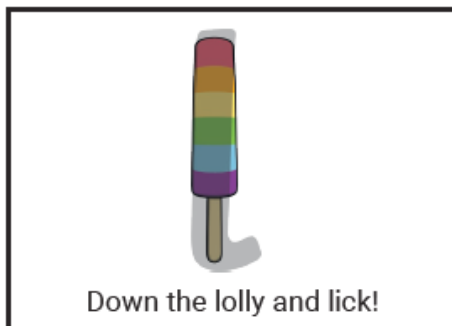

We have been learning about all of the travelling you can do on a bus as well as using our imagination.

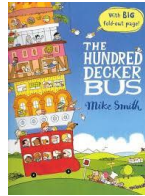
In Phonics we have been learning our new sound and letter 'l'.

Next Week

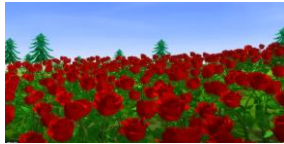
We will continue to read our focus book 'The Hundred Decker Bus.'

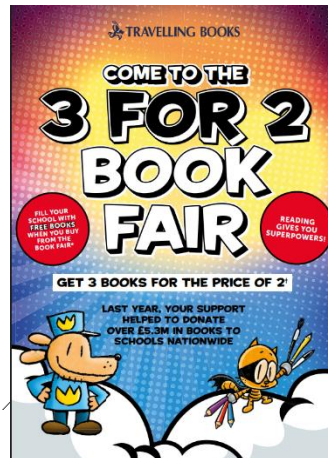
