After the Easter holiday we will look at the number bonds for 10.

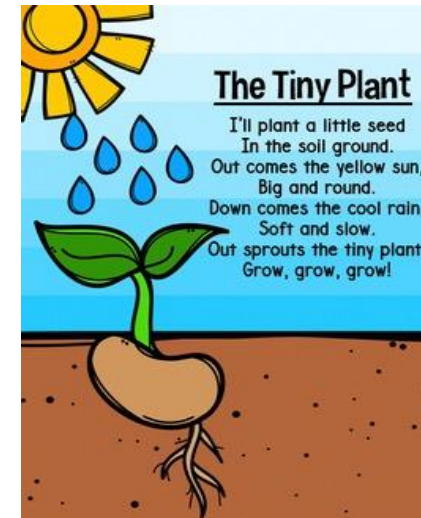
Homework - Please go over all the number bonds we have looked at so far (for 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9).
