A BIG, Warm Welcome!

Hello and Welcome to Yeading Nursery! Most of the children are already happy and settling into their new routine.

You have all been great at helping us to settle your children in. You should all be so proud of your little ones! We really appreciate your patience in waiting for the parents in front of you, while they settle their child and for following social distancing rules. Please wear a face mask when on the school grounds.

Next Week

We will continue to support your child with settling in to the routine, helping them to make choices and encouraging them to be independent. We will also be asking some of your children to paint a picture of themselves. Spend a little time talking to your child about what they have enjoyed at Nursery.

Books

Starting from 13th September, your children will be asked to choose a **book to bring home and share with you**. This will happen at the beginning of the session. A member of the team will help them with the experience. We will only give new books to the children if the previous books have been returned so please make sure that the book stays in your child's book bag.

Clothes

We would like to remind you that your children have to wear the **correct uniform**, which includes a jumper with the school's emblem and black leather shoes (not boots or plimsolls). We would also like to ask that all your children's items are clearly labelled with your child's name, including coats, shoes, water bottles and bags. If your child has their ears pierced please ensure that they only wear study to school. Thank you.

Snack Time

Please note that children should not be bringing in their own snacks into Nursery. We will provide a piece of fruit and some milk each day for the children.

Personal Hygiene

Children should be entering the nursery without nappies or pull-ups. Please support children at home by encouraging them to be independent when going to the toilet. The Children's Centre (next door) may be able to provide support to parents in this area. We ask you to register with them as quickly as possible.

Mobile Phones

The school has decided on a **NO mobile phone policy in school**. This means that when you are coming onto school grounds to collect or deliver children, we would kindly ask you to refrain from using your phone.

Absences

If your child is going to be absent, for whatever reason, please ensure that you ring the school office by 8.40am on 020 8573 3389 pressing **option 1** and leaving a message, stating your child's full name, class, and reason for absence.

Going home time

Your child's **safety** is **extremely** important to us. Going home time can be a busy time. We therefore ask that you continue to be patient when we are calling your children's names. We also ask that all parents and carers make a **line** at the door, to ensure that all of the children are sent home **safely**. We will also not be able to send your child home if you are using your mobile phone. We will not send your child home if you send a friend to collect your child if you have not informed the office or a member of staff before the end of the session. Therefore please let us know in advance. Thank you.
