## Literacy

**This week** we have been orally retelling the story 'The Little Red Hen' and using actions to support us.

**Next week**, we will be focusing on our favourite part of the story and talking about why it is our favourite part using the word 'because'.

**Homework** - Please discuss your child's favourite part in the story and encourage them to use the word 'because' to give reasons.

## Phonics

This week we started learning some of the phase 5 sounds and tricky words. Here are the sounds and tricky word we learnt this week: ea, oy, ir & looked.

**Homework** - Please continue to practise this week's sounds and tricky word.

## Maths

**This week** we have been solving subtraction word problems using counting back method and number lines.

**Next week** we will be looking at money and talking about the value of different coins.

**Homework** - Show your child all the different coins and notes you have in your purse. Discuss with your child what they notice about the different coins/notes (colour, size, shape). Write sentences about what they notice about each coin/note.
