<u>Literacy</u>

This week we have been describing our favourite characters from the story "Billy and the Beast".

Next week we will be changing a character from the story.

We will also be looking at different animals from Madagascar as part of our SDG project.

<u>Homework</u> – Find out what animals live in Madagascar. Some are unique to Madagascar. Draw and label a picture.

Look at "Billy and the Beast" story map and ask your child to change a character from the story ie: Larry the lemur has thick black fur. Larry and his friend Cassie the chameleon were climbing the trees in the forest, when etc

Phonics

We have been practising Phase 4 letter sounds: sk, lt, lp, if, pt, scr, shr, thr, nch, str, fr, nl, fl, gl, pl, cl, sl, sp, st, tw, sm, pr, sc, sk and sn. Please continue to practise Phase 4 sounds and tricky words for 10 minutes per evening, as well as blending words with your child. For example: bo-x, fea-th-er and ri-ng.

Homework - Please continue to practise cursive letter formations and blending at home for 10 minutes per evening.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we have continued learning about time and how to recognise o'clock and half past on an analog clock.



Next week, we will be learning to sequence number patterns. For example, counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
