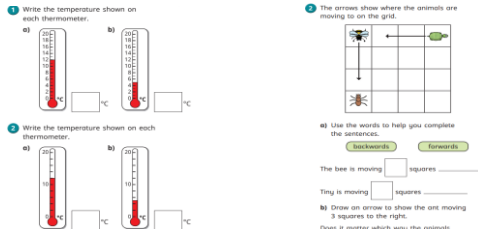

This week: We continued with mass and then moved on to capacity..

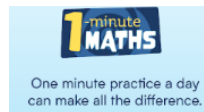
Next Week: We will be looking at reading temperature (thermometers) and then look at movement and turns.
