Maths

This week we have been learning number bonds to 5.

<u>Homework</u> - Learn your number bonds to 5 and then number bonds to 10.

E.g. 1+4=5 2+3=5 3+2=5 4+1=5 7+3=10 5+5=10

Please continue to practice number formations with your child to ensure numbers are the correct way round.
