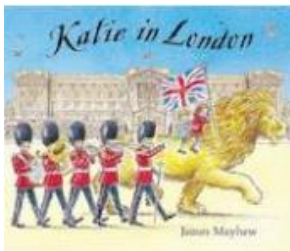

English

In English this week the children orally retold the events of the story from the perspective of the lion. They continued with their plan for the diary entry for their final diary entry next week. The

children have also been going over past SAT's papers in preparation for their end of KS1 formal assessment.

Home learning: Focus on punctuation such as capital letters and full stops. Understanding what these terms mean (Apostrophe, adjective, noun, verb and adverb)

Maths

This week the children have been learning about 3D- Shapes with a focus on their properties such as vertices, faces and edges. They also continue to revise a past SAT's papers in preparation for the end of year national assessment. Next week in maths the children will be learning about position and measure.

Home - learning practise: Continue to support your child with learning their times tables and writing down all the bonds of numbers that total 10 - 20 and 100 (focusing on the relationships e.g $1 + 9 = 10$ so $1 + 19 = 20$ and $9 + 11 = 20$ so $10 + \underline{\quad} = 100$)
