English

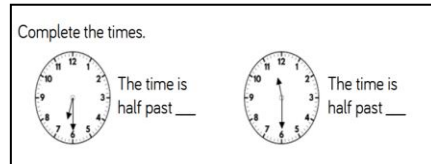


In English this week children completed a reading assessment. Children also learnt how to write an information text on penguins. We looked at different topic areas to do with penguins such as their description, diet and habitat. We also learnt some very fun facts about penguins! Ask your children what facts they discovered.

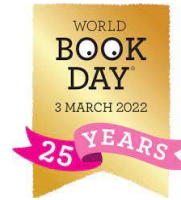
