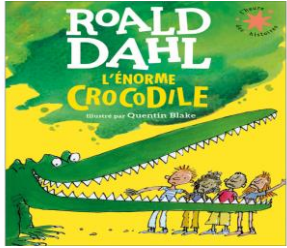

This week in maths the children continued learning about measuring with a particular focus on capacity (volume) and again reading standard units of measure such as millilitres and litres. They continue learning how to read different measurements of measuring jugs with different increments.
