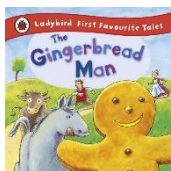

Please ensure your child's nails are cut short and filed down.

We ask that you teach and show children how to properly clean their runny noses so that we can limit germs spreading within Nursery.
