English

In English this week children have been ordering the events of the story and using role play to orally retell the story. The children have been encouraged to use a range of descriptive language to engage their audience.

Next week the children will be writing a retell of the story and changing some of the elements to make their own version.

Home learning: Encourage your child to write sentences about their day at school or their lunch time play. How about World Book Day or about our new school friend Indie?

Maths

This week the children were learning the relationships between fractions and time. e.g. half ($\frac{1}{2}$) and half past the hour - quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) and quarter past and quarter to the hour. We also learnt the fraction thirds ($\frac{1}{3}$)

Next week the children will be doing an assesment on their fraction learning and reading time.

Home learning practise: Continue to practise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables and practise using multiplication facts to complete division questions.

For example: $3 \times 5 = 15$ and 15 divided by 3 = 5 and 15 divided by 5 = 3 (and same for the 4 x table)
