English

This week the children started a new unit which is statistics. They were reading/interpreting pictograms and how to collect data using a tally.

Next week we continue with learning about statistics. The key vocabulary : **tally, chart, bar chart, block graph, interpret**

Home learning practise:

Continue to support your child with learning how to find more than one part of a fraction and use the bar model to check their calculations.
