

## **Our Learning**

This Week

The children are still enjoying <u>Oliver's Vegetables</u> by Vivian French, illustrated by Alison Bartlett.

We are talking about growing things from seeds and learning about vegetables and even trying new ones like rhubarb!

In Phonics we are learning the letter 'g' as in grass, goat and frog.

### **General Notices**

<u>Easter Holidays</u> Our last school day is Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March, finishing at 2pm. Children return for the Summer Term on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April.

#### **Mobile Phones**

When you are coming onto school grounds to collect or deliver children, we would kindly ask you to refrain from using your phone. Thank you.

So, what is school readiness? Well, we see it as a measure of how prepared a child is to succeed in school, cognitively, socially and emotionally. This allows teachers to focus on developing skills and stops young children playing 'catch up', so they can develop their love for school and parents can be confident that their child is coping well with the transition.

Sadly, the last statistical data shows that in Hillingdon 1 in 2 children are 'school ready' compared to Lewisham where about 3 in 4 children are school ready - fingertips.phe.org.uk 2014. And the pandemic will not have improved this situation. So, we are offering all parents of young children, who are about to go to school for the first time a free course, details are:

- School Readiness (online course) 10am to 12pm on Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> February to Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> March <u>LearnHillingdon - School Readiness</u> <u>CHO1049</u>
- School Readiness (online course) 7pm-9pm on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March to Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March (Learn Hillingdon - School Readiness CHO1050
