Literacy

This week we focused on Easter activities and looked at the celebrations of Eid and Vaisakhi. After the holiday the children will be writing about some of the things they did during their break.

Homework - Reading and fixing sentences linked to The Very Hungry Caterpillar story.

Phonics

This week we went over the last Phase 3 letter sounds: air (for chair), ure (for pure), and er (for hammer). and ear (for beard). We practised word blending with them.

Phase 3 tricky words: he, she, we, me, be, was, my, you, they, all, are, here.

Next term we will start looking at the Phase 5 sounds.

Homework - In the Phonic books please work with your child up to page 10 (Week 1, Day 4 and Day 5, and all the days 1-5 in Week 2).

Homework - Number bonds for 10, and addition and subtraction sums.

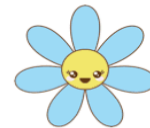
