This week the children continued learning how to interpret tally charts, pictograms and block graphs. Next week they will be learning how to find the line of symmetry of common 2D shapes

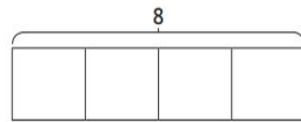
Home learning practise:
