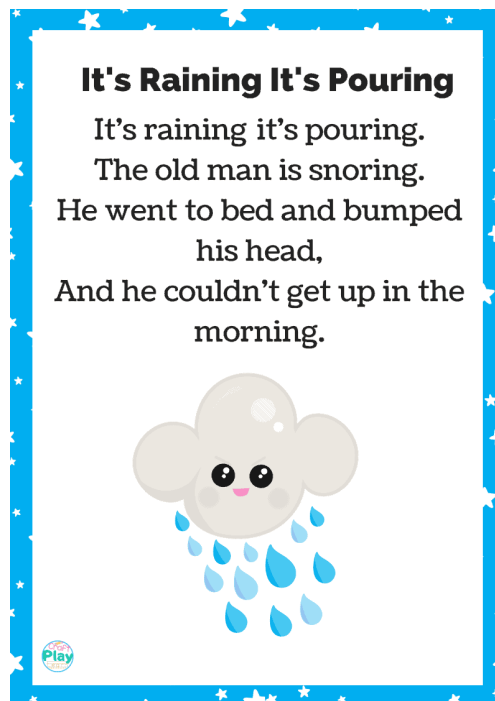

Our Learning

This Week

We have had a brilliant week and have started to enjoy the warmer weather! The children have had opportunities to explore their creative skills outdoors with paints and chalk. The children have also been creating and decorating their own pinch pots, which we will plant cress in next week.

We will start our new focus story 'Oliver's Vegetables' and the children will have opportunities to look at, touch, taste and describe all the different vegetables within the book. We will also discuss the importance of healthy eating!

We have been progressing with our sounds and tricky words and the children this week have been introduced to 'c' and 'k'. Take a look at the back of the newsletter to see the tricky words that children can be practicing at home.

We have been focusing on 'one more' and 'one less' in Numeracy and subitising to 5. It's fantastic to see all the progress children are making.

Next Week

With the warmer weather we would like to remind all parents to bring water bottles with names on. Hopefully we can continue to enjoy the sunshine next week and explore our outside area more. We will be building outside with our new wooden construction kits.

Before the half term break the children were given a **login username and password so that they can access Bug Club**. This is a wonderful online resource to encourage the children's enjoyment of stories and reading.
