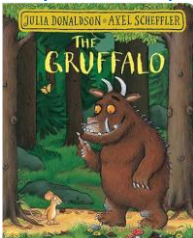
Literacy

Homework - Writing words to match the pictures.

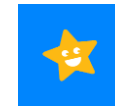
Maths
