Punctuality & Absence

Please continue to make sure children have high attendance in Nursery. If your child misses the start of their session they are missing out on important learning. We would also be grateful if you could please come to collect children on time.

If your child is going to be absent, for whatever reason, please ensure that you ring the school office by 8.40am on 020 8573 3389 pressing **option 1** and leaving a message, stating your child's full name, class, and reason for absence.

Home Time

Your child's **safety** is **extremely** important to us. We ask that you continue to be patient when we are calling your children's names. We also ask that all parents and carers make a **line** at the door, to ensure that all of the children are sent home **safely**. We will also not be able to send your child home if you are using your mobile phone. We will not send your child home if you send a friend to collect your child if you have not informed the office or a member of staff before the end of the session.
