Maths

This week children have been learning how to count forward/backwards, subtraction, finding parts.

Next week The children will be learning about fact families, finding the difference and comparing numbers.

Key Vocabulary: add, addition, subtraction, sums, total, systematic, difference, greater, less, smaller than, decreasing.
