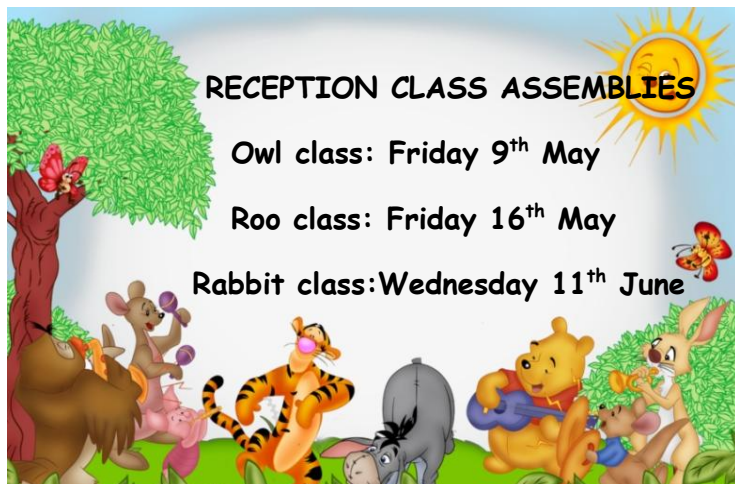

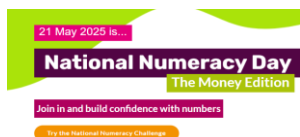

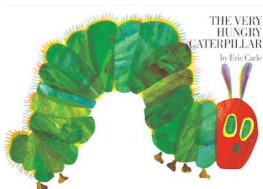
Reading
