This Week

The children have been enjoying the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears and been using 'big, medium and small' voices and have been sorting bowls, chairs and beds!

The children have been experiencing 'Write Dance'. This is a fun activity to help children with gross and fine motor skills in preparation for writing. ***If any parents have rolls of unused wallpaper at home we would be happy to use them for our Write Dance sessions.***

We have been talking to the children about feelings and how to be a good friend.

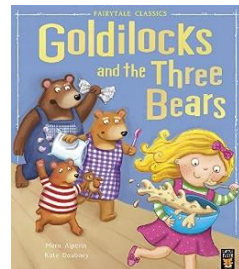

Health & Hygiene

Children should be entering the nursery without nappies or pull-ups. Please support children at home by encouraging them to be independent when going to the toilet. The Children's Centre (next door) may be able to provide support to parents in this area. We ask you to register with them as quickly as possible.

Please ensure your child's nails are cut short and filed down.

We ask that you teach and show children how to properly clean their runny noses so that we can limit germs spreading within Nursery.
