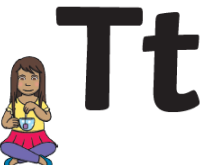

In Maths, we have been practising our number recognition and counting skills. While recapping what we have already learnt.

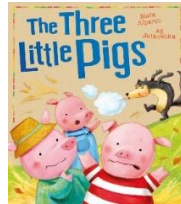
As it is our first week back after the break we have been revisiting the phonic sounds we learnt last half term.
