What We're Learning This Week!



Literacy

This week we have been looking at the story of "Dear Earth" using story map to re-tell and discuss about each event and begin to sequence the story.

Next week - We will be

Homework - Look at "Dear Earth" story map and talk to your child what happens at the beginning, middle and end of the story.

Phonics

This week we have been consolidating work on Phase 4 and 5 of the phonics ea as in Heather, e-e as in concrete, ee as in Queen and ey as in honey. In addition, we have looked at the tricky words.

Next week - we will continue to consolidate all the sounds from phase 4 and 5 such as: ie as in pie, ie (e) as in alien, igh as in night and i-e (e) as in like.

Homework - Children should now be writing sentences independently using their knowledge of Phase 2/3/4/5 supported by tricky words. Challenge your child to write about weekend news.

Maths

This week - we have been learning about 'Weight'. Children learnt to describe the capacities of objects and used key vocabulary about capacity. **Key words:**

Heavy	Heavier	Lighter	The same	More
Heaviest	Light	Lightest	Weight	Less

Next week - Our topic for next week is 'Length'. We will be learning to estimate the lengths of objects and then compare and order lengths.

Homework - Please encourage them to look at 'length' at home, use the key vocabulary and use the word in a sentence. E.g.

Long	Longer	Longest	Short	Shorter
Shortest	Tall	Taller	Tallest	Length
