Phonics

We will be continuing to work on Phase 4 and 5 of the phonics till the end of the summer term. This week we focused on phase 5 sounds ay, oy, ie, ea. For example, ay as in play, oy as in joy and ie as in pie.

This week the children were assessed on all the sounds we learnt this term. Next term we will be using Level 5 sounds to develop blending and support reading and writing.

Homework

Children should now be writing sentences independently using their knowledge of Phase 2/3/4/5 supported by tricky words.

Challenge your child to write about what they did over the holidays.

Maths

This week the children were assessed on all the topics we learnt this term. After the holidays we will explore different combinations of coins with a total of up to 20p.
