



#### This Week

This week we enjoyed taking part in Science Week. We explored many activities related to the topic of 'curiosity'.

We discussed dinosaur fossils and got to look at some in class.

The children thoroughly enjoyed our milk colour experiment. We used milk, food colours and cotton bud with washing up liquid on them. They saw how the colours moved.

Then we talked about light and dark and how we need light to create shadows. We took the learning outside and saw shadows all around us.

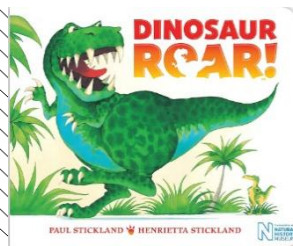
#### **Ducklings arrived!**
