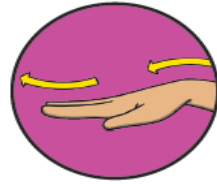

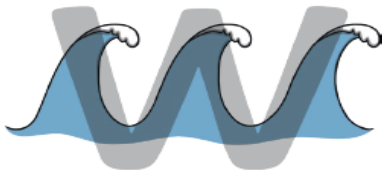

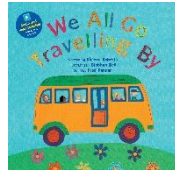
In Phonics we have been learning our new sound and letter 'w'.
