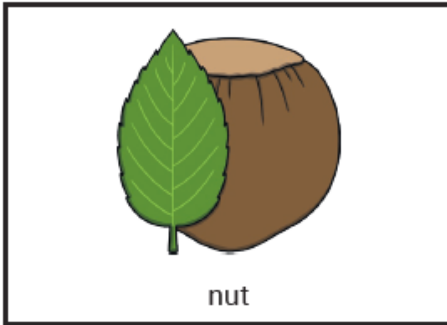


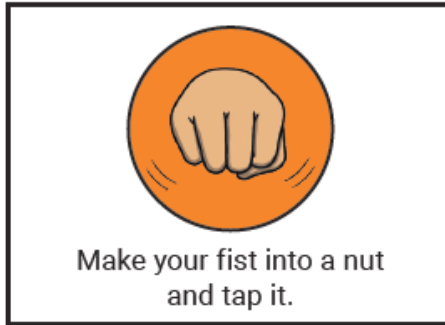

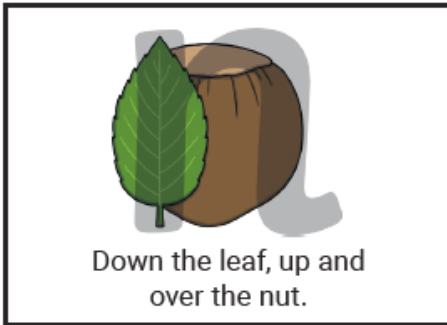

This Week

This week we read 'The Three Little Pigs' for the last time and we acted out the story using actions and phrases from the book. The children enjoyed using our story path to sequence the story.

In Phonics we are learning letter 'n' with lots of fun activities to encourage interaction and mark making. Please see the guidance sheet on the back of the newsletter to show you how we teach this sound.

In maths, learning about the number 5. What different groups of objects can we make using 5?
5 red bears, 5 yellow pencils or 5 toy cars. The children have been able to see we can use many objects to show and understand the number 5.

Also, it is the Great Garden Bird watch this week 23rd January to 25th January. The children have made their own bird feeder to take home. Over the weekend do look at how many birds to see and the different kinds of birds. We would love to know how you did on your own birdwatch.
